## Biographical/Historical note

Mark Anthony Frenaye was born February 5, 1783. According to his own written and repeated statements, he built up a competent fortune by careful methods and attention to business, as a merchant in Philadelphia. By a generous loan of thirty thousand dollars, he enabled Bishop Kenrick to begin the building of the church of St. John the Evangelist under the pastoral direction of the Rev. John Hughes, 1831. From the early thirties until a short time before his death, Frenaye lived at St. John's Rectory. Mr. Frenaye died in St. Joseph's Hispital, Philadelphia, January 4th, 1873.

## **Scope and Contents note**

The collections contains correspondence to and from Marc Freyane, collected by the American Catholic Historical Society of Philadelphia. A number of the letters are in French.

Series I contains Frenaye correspondence with numerous clergy and laypeople, including most of the bishops around the country, such as Bishop Peter Kenrick of St. Louis and Michael O'Connor of Pittsburgh. Topics cover finances and fundraising, with many asking for or repaying Frenaye. Letters also include discussions of books, social matters, and the spread of Catholicism.

Series II contains correspondence to and from Freyane that were added at a later point as well as some that were likely taken from other collections, namely the correspondence with the Rodrigue family. There is also correspondence that is neither to nor from Freyane but were part of the collection when it was originally processed and assigned numbers.
