1	I	Gift of books and papers from family of James O'Brien, deceased 1978. Address of family 312 Carpenter Lane, Phila., Pa. 19119. O'brien was the American diplomat in Italy. ca 1923. A Newspaper of "The Fifth Horseman" , dated Sept. 25, 1923 but as a joke, Headline on paper is DOOM CRACKS END OF WORLD"
2		Papers on "The Future of the Fascisti", and another on "The Catholic Church and the Human Evolutionary Hypothesis, and another small sheet on "Carne Congelata". Another on Bonds, Mortgage loan bank and simply loans.
3		A page from the Evening Public Ledger dated Feb. 6, 1923. referring to Diplomatic Hysteria, and Art Museum Inquiry reveals some guilty facts. and talks on "thinking Philadelphians." and a correspondence on "The Friendly Sons of St. Patrick.
4		Booklet on "Commercial Law Brief" 1921, Genoa Italy. A recognition card for Rowing Club for O'Brien, and a small writeup in newspaper of "La partenza di Mr. O'Brien.-
5		Papers on American Diplomat in Italy. A letter written in Italian from DeGeiprgos to O'Brien, referring to loans & bonds placed in Italy with no tax. Also a letter to DeGeiorgis concerning the importation of Broom Corn etc. and other correspondence back and forth on finacial matters and importation with Kenneth Joll & Co., Genoa, Italy.
6		Letter from the Embassy of the U.S.A. to Rome, Italy, concerning the project of a new improved automobile apparatus "Asper" along with blueprints of this auto. A letter from the American Consular Service on staying in Italy and climate, etc. Also a letter to Mr. O'Brien expressing regret on his resignation as treasurer from Eliz. Maier.
7		Papers to Rev. John O'Rourke on Catholic Commentary on Holy Scripture. Two printed leaflets on second edition "The Spirit & Purpose of the Commentary". Typed up sheets (64 sheets) on 1 Corinthians, Bibliography-Introduction etc.
