














Pope John Paul II is welcomed enthusiastically wherever he travels around the globe. His frequent trips have generated many exciting new projects for the Pontiff. Indeed, this very magazine came about as a result of the Pope's visit to Japan in February, 1981.

Father Julian is a Polish priest now serving at the Shibuya Catholic Church in Tokyo. He is also a close friend and neighbor of the Marvel Comics representative in Japan, Gene Pelc. Intrigued by Marvel's biography of St. Francis, Francis, Brother of the Universe, Fr. Julian passed copies of it to members of the Pope's entourage during the Tokyo visit.

Malinski related events that have never before been told to the general public in any medium. True insights and facts about Pope John Paul II are told for the first time in this Marvel magazine. with Fr. Malinski were severely hampered.

Adding to the drama of the creation of this work was the assassination attempt on the Pope in Rome. Fr. Malinski flew to the Vatican to cover the situation firsthand.
